#### Pope Francis

#### U.S. News

Two 20th Century U.S. chaplains are advancing towards Canonization.

- + Fr. Joseph Lafleur, Louisiana. Ordained 1938. Chaplain Army Air Corps., taken captive in the Philippines by the Japanese. In POW camps, gave up his food and medicines to other soldiers. Made sure the soldiers received the Sacraments at great risk to himself. Being brought to Japan 1944, ship was torpedoed. He was seen helping other POWs as ship went down. He was 32 years of age. He served God and his Country.
- + Brother Marinus. Benedictine monk. He served in the Korean War. Captain of the U.S.S. Meredith Victory. Chinese communists has 1,000s of Korean refugees surrounded. Bravely he guided his ship to shore and took 14,000 men aboard. He entered the Benedictines 1954 till his death 47 years later. He is revered in South Korea for his courageous actions.

Sunday 6/5 will be the last Pancake Breakfast until fall. Immediately following the 9AM Mass.










Christopher Major ordained Permanent Deacon May 28th at St. Mary's Cathedral. St. Isabella parishioners joined the celebration.
