First Sunday of Advent

Matthew 24 : 37 - 44

Today we begin a new liturgical year and the Gospel of Matthew, and the Season of Advent in preparation for Christmas. The Gospel conveys a sense of urgency. Time to Wake Up, Be Real, Be Prepared, Stay Awake, Be Ready. This season is not a time to be seen as doing nothing.

Vatican Trivia

The relics library is the most unusual library in the world. Relics that go back to the 1st Century A.D. in a steel chamber in steel cabinets managed by one priest. Canon Law requires that every altar has a relic enclosed within the altar of every Catholic Church. It is from this library relics are sent to Catholic Churches throughout the world.

Catechesis

How is Mary a virgin if James is Jesus' brother?

Families in Jesus time were broader than just blood brothers but included cousins as family (as brothers.) Scripture uses the word brethren, meaning extended family.
