#### **Second Sunday of Easter**

John 20: 19 - 31

After the resurrection of Christ, in his appearances, peace is a major spirit he offers and requests of his followers. He uses peace more often after his resurrection than during his three year ministry. It is clear his faith is not to be a militant force but a peaceful force. His Church is to bring people together as brothers and sisters not as foes and enemies.

<u>Divine Mercy Sunday</u> - Second Sunday of Easter, focuses on the gift of mercy and love given through Christ's death, burial, and resurrection.

#### Pope Francis

Pope Francis delivered his Easter "*Urbi et Orbi*" message: 'Risen Christ is "Hope that does not disappoint", "Hope and solidarity in pandemic times", "Hope that brings peace to our world", "Living as brothers and sisters", "Overcome the mindset of war", "Healed by the wounds of Christ".' He concluded, saying: "We *pray that the benefits of that healing will spread throughout the world. Happy Easter to all of you!*"


