The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

John 16 : 12 - 15



It is not that Jesus never spoke about the Trinity but the apostles never understood what he said. As much as we cannot quite grasp Trinity, but the words of Christ remain: *I and the Father are one. I return to my Heavenly Father. This is my Beloved Son. I will send the Holy Spirit to you. He will guide you and teach you the truth. Father, into your hands, I commend my Spirit.*



Catechesis

John's Gospel says, "The Father and I are one." (John 10:30). Yet in John 14:28, he says "The Father is greater than I." Explain.

Theologians would say Jesus as God is equal to his Father, but as man he is less than his Father. Another words, human nature is less than the divine nature.

Catholic Media

The U.S. Bishops will be shutting down their 100 year old news service at the end of 2022. Catholic News Services (CNS) is another loss of catechesis to Catholic communities. The financial costs are simply too much. Dioceses in the past years have also been closing down their newspapers. This is a worrying trend for the Church. Will we have religious communications that stand up for the Church against secular media in the future?
