#### Fr. Michael McGivney Beatification: (Part 2 of 3)

Today there are 2 million men members of the Knights of Columbus. Fr. McGivney was born of working class Irish immigrants of 13 children, Michael, being the oldest, Waterbury, Connecticut. Ordained 1877, where he ministered to Irish immigrant families in a time of deep anti-Catholic bigotry. On March 29, 1882, Fr. McGivney and two dozens men founded the Knights in the basement of the church to financially support families in financial need that suffered the loss of their fathers in death. Little did these men know the impact this organization will have on the worldwide Catholic Church.






