(cont.) Who is Saint Joseph?

- 8. Joseph married Mary under proper Judaic laws
- 9. After the census, they went down to Egypt to escape Herod's massacre of the infants. A journey of 175 miles. They stayed three months, then returned to Nazareth.
- 10. At 13 years, Jesus in a Nazareth synagogue received Bar Mitzvah (Son of the Law)
- 11. Tradition has it Joseph died happily at home, family alongside him, which gave him Patron of a Happy Death
- 12. There is no burial site of Joseph to visit, or of Mary. Saint Joseph is elevated above all other saints. He practiced extraordinary and ordinary virtues to the fullest.
