

Vatican

A group of U.S. Bishops have asked the Vatican to add a feast day to honor the marriage of Mary & Joseph. The Bishops stated since sacramental marriage is being rejected in the U.S., the Bishops felt this would be a good way to hold up the union of Mary and Joseph as a model for all spouses to emulate. The Vatican declined this request stating there are no plans to add to the universal liturgical calendar at this time.
