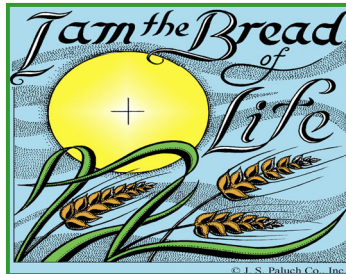

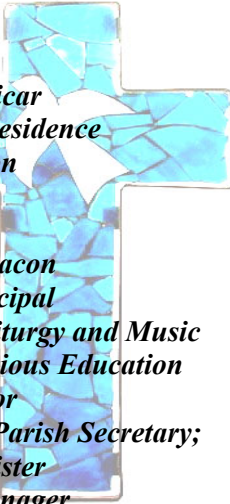

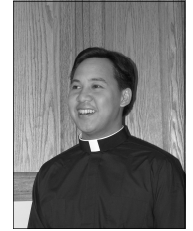

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



This weekend let us reflect on how most of us are so-busy. Many of us hold down more than one job, and we never seem to have enough time. We are workers, volunteers, parents, friends, and it is often difficult to keep track of our many commitments.

We seldom view our ordinary work as being the work of God.
