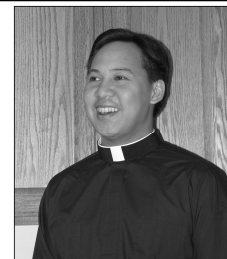

HOME IS WHERE THE FAMILY IS



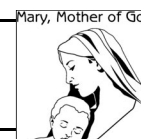

SUPERBOWL PARTY 2018

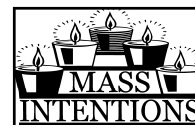
