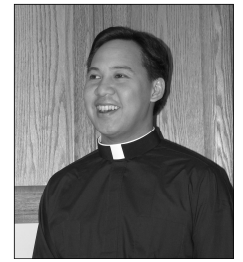

GOD FORGIVES

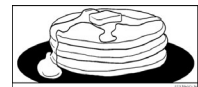

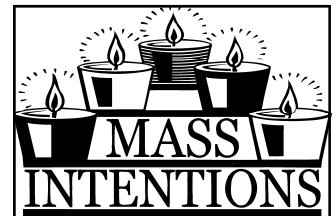
