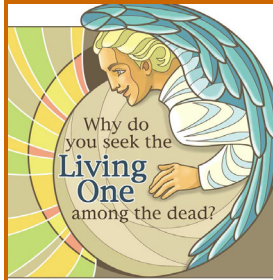

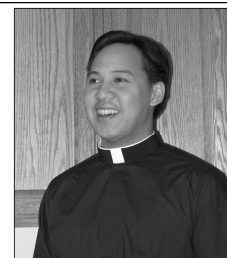

From the Pastor





Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

4. Ask for Divine Mercy (perform some works of mercy to others)

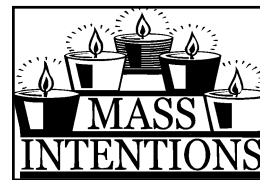
NOTE: On this weekend, the Spanish Mass will be held at 1:00 pm instead of 2:00 pm, due to the Divine Mercy Service

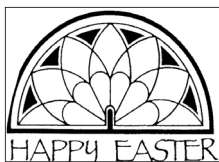
