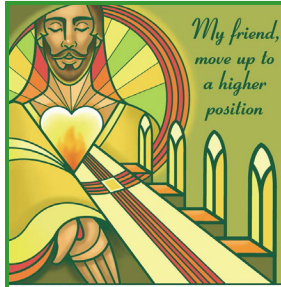

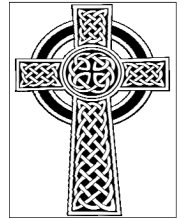
From the Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,


HUMILITY

The Blessed Mother Rosary group meets on Mondays at 5:00 pm, in the church. All are welcome to pray the rosary with us.



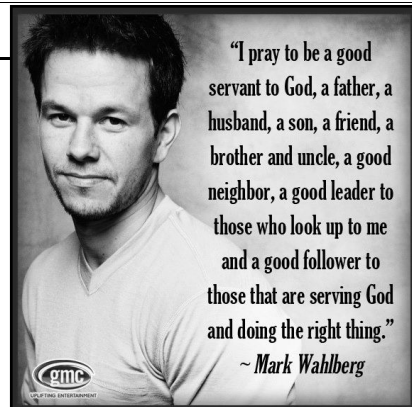
Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

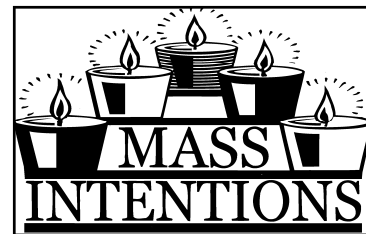
