This year has been a challenging year for all of us, especially the families in our St. Isabella's community, who have experienced illness or job loss due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

We are grateful for your past support of our work, which has enabled us to:

- Provide grocery gift cards for families in need of food. Our Conference does not have a food pantry available at our Church. Food collected in our barrel is given to St. Raphael's for our clients on Lincoln Avenue.
- Help families undergoing a financial crisis through our home visit program, by giving them assistance with critical expenses such as rent, utilities, medical bills and furniture.

The pandemic forced the cancellation of the Annual Bocce Fund-raiser this year. In the past our conference has received 25% of the net income from St. Raphael's. But now we are offering a fun opportunity for you to help – the annual "Pennies from Heaven" raffle sponsored by the Marin District Council of St. Vincent de Paul. The Grand Prize is \$1,000 in cash. **100% of the proceeds from tickets we sell at St. Isabella's will be used to fund our work here in Terra Linda Area.**
