John 2:13 - 25

A parishioner asked me. How could the father allow his son to be sacrificed on a cross, this kind of suffering he endured, how could he permit this? My only answer was, love is sacrifice. Love always sacrifices. But this is cruel, unacceptable and horrendous, all true and tells us how decrepit the human condition can go to. But it also tells us how deep love can reach. The greater the sacrifice the deeper love is.

#### Parish reflection

#### The Four Last Mysteries Christians Encounter: Death, Hell, Heaven, Judgement

<u>Death</u> (Part 1 of 4 cont.): Death is seen by both believers and non-believers as the end of physical existence. The Catholic Church sees death in the context of Jesus Resurrection. God does not rejoice in destruction but fashioned all things that they might have being – life. Original sin caused the loss of heavenly union with God we once had, therefore eternity without God is a real possibility. Through Jesus life, death and resurrection, death has no longer power over us. Life is changed not ended at death. We pass from this life to another way of living life after we die to this world.

<u>The Carmelite Sisters</u> had given the school the California Missions models they had. We will remember the sisters in our thoughts and prayers.


