Pope Francis Reflections on Prayer (Part 1 of 3)

1. Prayer is not soft and gentle. Prayer might often be hard and difficult, but it is for more life changes. That is what prayer does.
2. Make prayer a daily habit. Pope Francis recommends we pray at the beginning of the day. It will make us more courageous, freer and happier.
3. We must not pick and choose whom we like to pray for. Pray for everyone, we all belong to God. We should pray for those who seem far from God, unhappy people, those who have lost hope, enemies, criminals, disenfranchised. We are their intercessors before God.
4. We are not made to run all the time. Our busy lives may prevent us from hearing our inner life. A special place where we can wait for God. Be alone with him, quietness, silence where God's voice is heard.



Baltimore Catechism: Definition of a Sacrament.

A visible sign, instituted by Christ, signifying and producing sanctifying grace in the soul.

For example, Baptism. Visible sign—Water. Sanctifying Grace—Brought into Christ's life, his holy spirit; brought into supernatural life. Instituted by Christ, his command to the Apostles, go out into the world and baptize.

Theology of Work (Part 1 of 3)

We spend most of our lives working yet we rarely think there is theology to work. We were created to work. For human beings it is impossible not to work. It is what has brought us from cavemen to a highly technical society today. Bureaucrats, politicians rarely praise work. When they describe good jobs, they do not talk about scrubbing toilets because it is not a status job. Yet it is a most important job for our health—for hygiene. Next time you see a janitor, remember that. His work, his job purpose could be more important than the real estate man, the bank manager, the post woman; because without someone taking care of our health and hygiene, we would be a damaged race.
