Catechesis

Should we pray the Saint Michael prayer at Mass?

Actually no. Only prayers of the Eucharist are allowed during Mass. The Roman Rite make no provision for prayers after Mass. Once the priest dismissed the laity, no one needs to stick around for more prayers.

Types of Prayers

Divine Office, usually recited by monks and nuns, is the daily prayers of the Church marking the hours of each day and sanctifying the day with prayer. It uses Scripture, Psalms, and Prayers. The practice goes back to the early Church. The Office is prayed 7 times a day, prior to dawn to mid-night. St. Isabella does Matins each morning at 8:15 a.m. Apps are available on your cell phone to pray the Office also.

Ukraine

Christianity came to Ukraine around 800 AD. Bishops loyal to Constantinople rejected Rome's authority but many Ukrainians remained loyal to Rome, especially in the west of the country. They believe 100% in the Catechism. Russia has demanded they repudiated the Papacy. Many would not comply and have paid an awful price.
