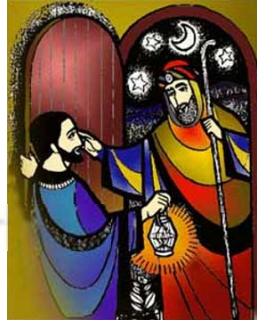
## Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
