## Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 18 : 1 - 8

August 27, 2022, in Rome, 21 churchmen were elevated to the Cardinalate, making it 132 Cardinals eligible to elect the next Pope. % of Cardinals from regions of the world: Europe 40%, Latin America 18%, Asia 16%, Africa 13%, North America 10%, Oceania 2%.
