Whose Land Is It? (Part 2 of 4)

God promised a land to Abraham but it took generations before his descendants left Egypt and arrived on Canaanites land looking for food in times of famine (Moses era). They will have to eradicate the indigenous people to claim the land. Two Israelite kingdoms were formed. In the north, Solomon; in the south, Judah David. Egypt named these lands Palestine, not Israelite. These two kingdoms were both conquered—by the Assyrian Empire, later by the Babylonians and Israel vanished from the land. Solomon's Temple was destroyed.

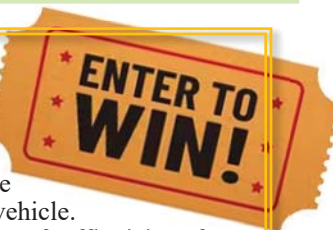
