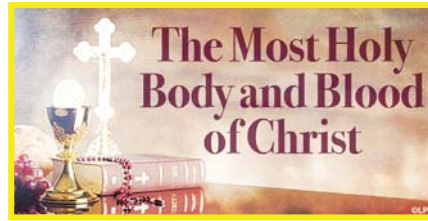


Corpus Christi
