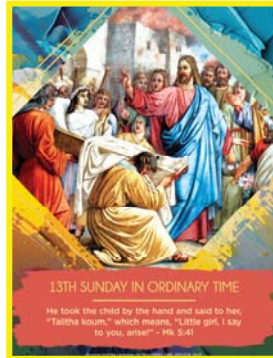


# Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

### Church Councils

Council of Basel, 1431. Over 700 delegates attended. The heresy of Janelius debated. He rejected Catholicism, simony, indulgences and blamed the Catholic Church for the schism, rejected Pope Alexander V as Pope, and the Bible is the only authority not the Catholic Church.
