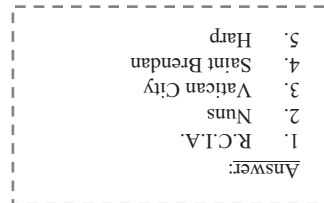
1. More inclusion in the Church
