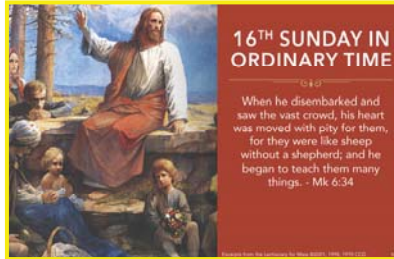


Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
