Purpose: To bring the Church into the modern world. Attended by 2,500 bishops.

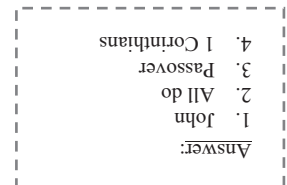
Discussions:

8. Laity to have decision making in parishes



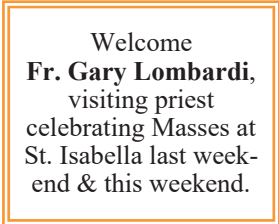
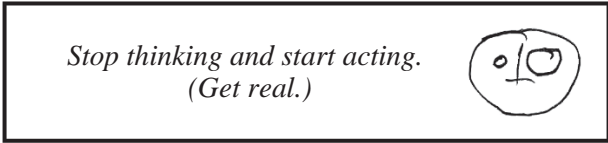

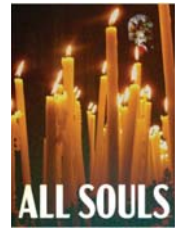
