John 21 : 1 – 19

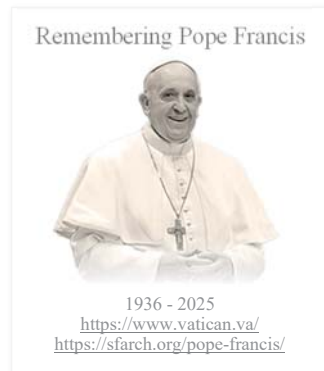

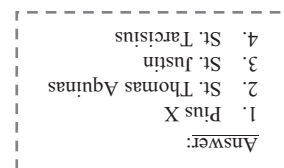
Pope Francis
